**GRAMMAR:** In the last class, you learnt the words for he, they, you, you all, I and we. In this lesson, we will learn the words for his, their, your, my, and our. In fact, they are not words in Arabic. They come as part of a word. We therefore learn these forms by attaching them to a noun  $\tilde{\zeta}$  (Lord; sustainer and cherisher).

ندگُر **& : A simple method:** Follow the following four steps

- > ASK: Each verse of the Qur'an demands something from us. To fulfill it, start with supplication.
- > EVALUATE (your past day or week in the light of that supplication)
- Make a PLAN of the next day / week.
- > PROPAGATE the message (The Prophet pbuh said: Convey from me even if it is one verse).

#### While Making plans

- > When it comes to group or Figh issues or any new idea, then please check with scholars before you mention it to others or implement it.
- > Then what is the real area for common people like us? Well, there are many areas such as: Our relationship with Allah, Following the Prophet pbuh, planning for the hereafter, Zikr, Worship, Morals, Dealings, Dawah, Preaching and Propagation, Ordering good and Stopping evil, Team spirit etc.
