Br Ahmed Hassan, our local haafidh alhamdulillah is again leading Taraweeh in this blessed month.

The 'Isha' iqaamah is at **9pm** until 7 April (end of daylight saving), and then **7.45pm** until the end of Ramadan inshaAllaah. Please ensure the mobiles are switched off whilst in the masjid. Please ensure your children are supervised at all times and any disruptive children not be brought to the masjid.

Iqaamah/Jama'ah times

Daily jama'ah/iqaamah times can be viewed on screens around the masjid as well as our website. As a general guide:

MAGHRIB – 10 minutes after sunset
'ISHAA' – 9pm; 7.45pm when daylight saving ends
FAJR – approx. 30 mins after published time
DHUHR – 1.35pm; 12.30pm when daylight saving ends
'ASR – 10 mins after published time
JUMU'AH – 1.20pm; 1pm sharp when daylight saving ends

Iftaar and I'tikaaf - feed the fasting at the masjid
